

Sandia Heights Artists Tour 2022

Non-Resident Artist Agreement & Application

Sandia Heights Artists will be presenting our 19th annual Studio Tour September 17-18, Sat-Sun from 10am-5pm in the homes and gardens of our residents. There will be a few openings for guest artists who do not live in our area, and this application will be your entry for jurying.

All guest artists who are selected will be placed into one of our resident artist's homes. Our normal tour features 36 artists in approximately 12-14 stops enabling patrons to see a majority of our art. We prefer to have clusters of 2-4 artists per stop. Our brochure includes a photo of each artist's work on the tour.

- All artists participating are required to serve on one of our many committees and attend our monthly evening meetings in order to make the tour a success.
- Cost of guest artist participation in the show is \$150, contingent upon acceptance, with notification by June 15th. Fees go towards advertising and marketing of the show.
- The Tour also supports a charity every year with a donation box for tour visitors to add donations at each stop. All participating artists also donate an amount from their sales to the charity. For example, the suggested minimum last year from each artist was \$35.

Registration: Artists must complete this application/agreement for the jurying process, and mail in the completed form to be received no later than May 15 to the address at the end of this form. A completed agreement must also include high resolution digital images of 5-7 pieces of artwork, sent separately to Lynda@lyndaburch.com. Images sent should include a list of titles, mediums, size, and retail price. All work should be of original design, material, and execution.

Jurying Information: A panel of 4 resident artists will review your art based on **craftsmanship, composition, originality, diversity of mediums with SHA residents, and your ability to bring with you a customer following.** Selections will be finalized by June 15, at which time, if selected, your \$150 fee will be due. An appropriate host home will be assigned after that.
