QUALITY AND ORIGINALITY OF WORK.

All your own original ideas and work. No kit materials. Only artist quality photocopies of originals may be sold as prints.

DIVERSITY OF MEDIUMS AND STYLES INCLUDED IN THE STUDIO TOUR

Your work is excellent but we cannot feature only abstract artists, potters and jewelers. Please understand, we need a fair representation from multiple media and will need to make choices.

CONTRIBUTION TO SANDIA HEIGHTS ART EVENTS AND COMMITTEES

All guest artists chosen will need to attend monthly evening planning meetings (distance not an excuse), special events such as preview night showings, and must actively participate in the work of one or two committees preparing for the SHA Art Tour. Participation by previous guests will be verified.

ABILITY TO ATTRACT A CUSTOMER FOLLOWING

We appreciate your ability to add your customers to our 2023 Studio Art Tour.

ANY ADDITIONAL CRITERIA AS DEFINED BY THE JURY COMMITTEE

REGISTRATION PROCESS:

The Guest Application is available online at www.sandiaheightsartists.com. Once completed, press the Submit button. Choose 5 high quality photos that represent the work you would display during the Tour. Email those jpgs to sandiaheightsartists@gmail.com Refer to Photo and Bio Submission Guidelines at the website. Application and photos are due by April 1, 2023. Both application and photos will be reviewed by the Jurying Committee.

IF YOU ARE CHOSEN TO BE A GUEST ARTIST FOR THE 2023 STUDIO ART TOUR:

- You will be notified in mid to late April. You will have two weeks to confirm your decision to join us at the Tour. You will submit your \$125 entry fee to our Treasurer during that two weeks.
- You will be assigned a Host home for your display.
- Each year, the Tour supports a local charity with a donation box at each Host home. Each artist is asked to donate an amount from their sales. The suggested minimum last year was \$35.
- You are expected to be respectful of your Host's home and leave your designated place clean upon departure. The Host, as well as Sandia Heights Artists, is not responsible for any theft or damage to artists' display, or personal belongings during the tour or overnight during tour dates. All artists agree to hold harmless SHA, its officers, and its members, from any claims whatsoever arising from the SHA Studio Tour and other SHA events, or from the cancellation of any SHA event if cancellation is deemed warranted by SHA.
